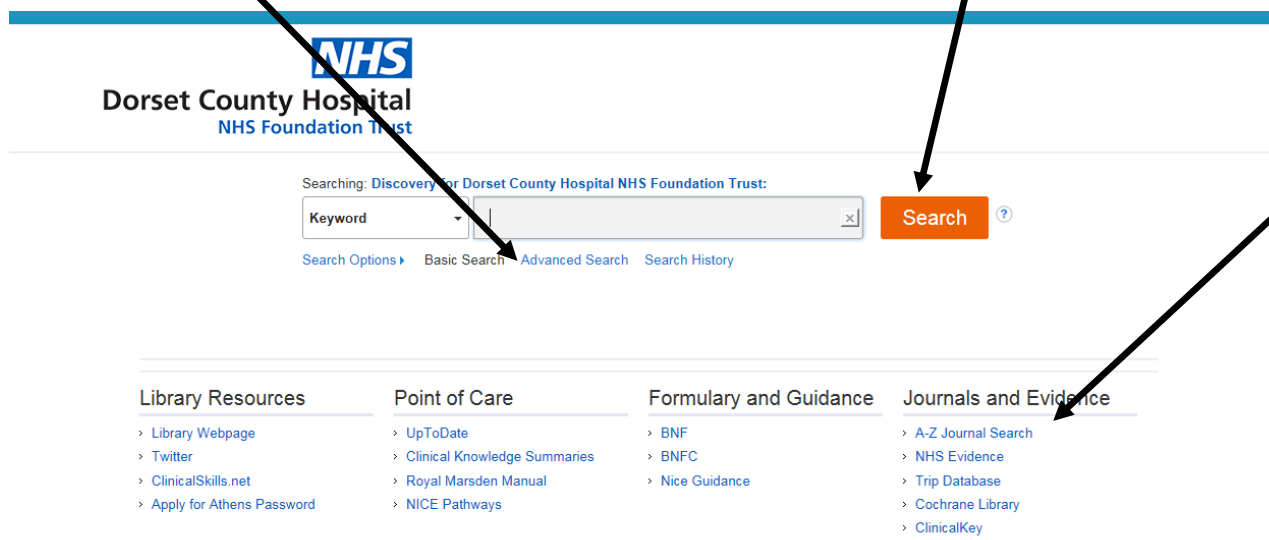
How to access Discovery Search:

How to use Discovery Search

1. Begin a new search by selecting “Basic” or “Advanced” Search

2. Enter your search term into the search box and click “Search”. You can enter keywords or a specific book or journal title.



3. Links to other useful resources, like A-Z Journals and NHS Evidence

4. For full access you will need an OpenAthens username and password—register for an account at <https://openathens.nice.org.uk/>
