Knowledge Café – Topic: How do you do a literature search?

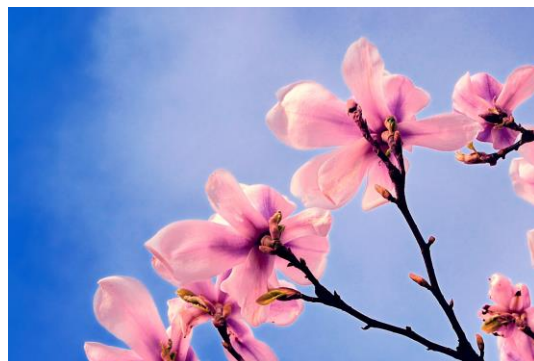
